Although the Company does not manufacture end user equipment every effort is made through our supply chain to ensure that such the parts for the intended equipment is sourced responsibly with regard to environmental and social accountability considerations. Wherever practical, suppliers implementing an environmental management system shall be selected. Customer requirements however take precedence in specifying raw materials.

The Company recognises the responsibility that it has upon the environment and strives to minimise the impact by implementing appropriate controls to minimise and recycle waste wherever possible.

Machine programming optimisation and efficient job planning ensures raw material waste is minimised.

All waste is appropriately segregated and disposed of by licensed recycling specialists.

In the event that major equipment or plant is to be disposed of, use of licensed recycling facilities shall be used wherever possible particularly for hazardous materials.

All manufactured product shall meet applicable legislative directives with respect to safety and the environment such as COSHH, RoSH & WEEE.
