

## Purchase, Transfer or Import of Materials Originating from Russia

### European Council Regulation (EU) 833/2014

The above regulation prohibits the purchase, transfer or import of goods that originate or are exported from Russia.

In response to recent government announcements regarding the further strengthening of sanctions imposed on Russia effective 1<sup>st</sup> October 2023, JM Automatics Ltd wish to assure our customers that metals (aluminium, stainless steel, copper, and brass) purchased for the fulfilment of orders do not originate from Russia.

We have obtained written confirmation from our material suppliers that Russian originated materials are no longer sourced and as such excluded from any supplies to JM Automatics Ltd.

JM Automatics Ltd confirm that we are fully aware of the current restrictions and requirements and assure our customers of our continued commitment to actively manage our supply chain to ensure there is no inherited risk of exposure to Russian originated materials.

The validity of this statement extends indefinitely, and any breach or change of this declaration will be advised to our customers immediately and published on our website.
